PTA HONORARY SERVICE AWARD

Pine Valley PTA is looking for nominees for Honorary Service Awards. The Honorary Service Award (HSA) program encourages PTA units to honor individuals or organizations through donations to the HSA program fund of the California State PTA (a scholarship and grant program).

The goals of the HSA program are as follows:

- To recognize deserving PTA, school and community volunteers for outstanding service to children and youth.
- To provide funds for the scholarship and grant program.

The applicants being considered should be recognized for outstanding service to children and youth, not for routine assigned responsibilities or for retirement. ***Those who work behind the scenes, quietly and efficiently, should also be considered.***

AWARDS/CRITERIA

Very Special Person (VSP): May be given to an individual or PTA constituent organizations to recognize having contributed to the school community in a special way.

Honorary Service Award (HSA): May be given to an individual or organization in the PTA, school, or community in special recognition of outstanding service to children and youth.

Continuing Service Award (CSA): May be given to an individual or organization in the PTA, school, or community for recognition of outstanding service to children and youth. This award may be given to a person whose contributions have been significant over a continuing period of time. The award may be given regardless of whether a recipient has previously received the California State PTA's Honorary Service Award.

Golden Oak Service Award: This is the most prestigious PTA award in California. This award may be given to an individual or organization that has made significant contributions to the welfare of children and youth in the PTA, school, or community.

Outstanding Teacher Award

The Outstanding Teacher Award may be given to a teacher in special recognition for outstanding service in positively impacting the lives and welfare of children and youth in the PTA, school, or community.

Outstanding Administrator Award

The Outstanding Administrator Award may be given to an administrator in special recognition for outstanding service in positively impacting the lives and welfare of children and youth in the PTA, school, or community.
